Because the middle class in Zambia is only recently emerging, there are large numbers of bright, qualified students who are able to finish high school but remain stuck in a cycle of poverty because they cannot afford university education.

Our ONE STUDENT Scholarship Program provides funding for students who not only attend Northrise University, but then go on to successful careers, benefiting their entire family and breaking generational cycles. Scholarship recipients are required to engage in work study jobs on campus, and experience one on one discipleship to develop their spiritual maturity and character. In many cases, graduates from the program will fund the education of their family members, multiplying the impact of a scholarship.
