Dear Friend,



Christine was among the first Northrise University School of Nursing graduates. When Christine and her family celebrated her graduation in June 2022, few people knew the hardships and challenges she experienced to get to that special day.

Christine was born in Lusaka, Zambia, but her parents separated when she was three years old. After they separated, her mom moved to Tanzania, and Christine lived with her father. When Christine was seven years old, her father married another woman and Christine moved in with her grandmother. Christine started school a bit later in life because the distance between the home she shared with her grandmother and school was a two-hour walk.

Christine remarked, "If you want to succeed in Zambia, you need to get an education. If you don't get an education, you won't get a proper job."

Christine, now a single mother to three kids, knows the importance of her

children receiving a quality education and building a strong foundation. Christine is determined to see her children get a better education than she did growing up.

Several years ago, Christine was employed but struggled to provide a flourishing life for her children. Thanks to generous friends of Northrise University, in July 2017, Christine received a scholarship to NU and was part of the first intake of nursing students in the brand-new School of Nursing.

While the journey has been challenging, Christine's drive comes from the desire to have a prosperous life for herself and her children.


