The student resource portal is an online platform that provides students with access to important resources such as course materials, announcements, forms, and academic information.

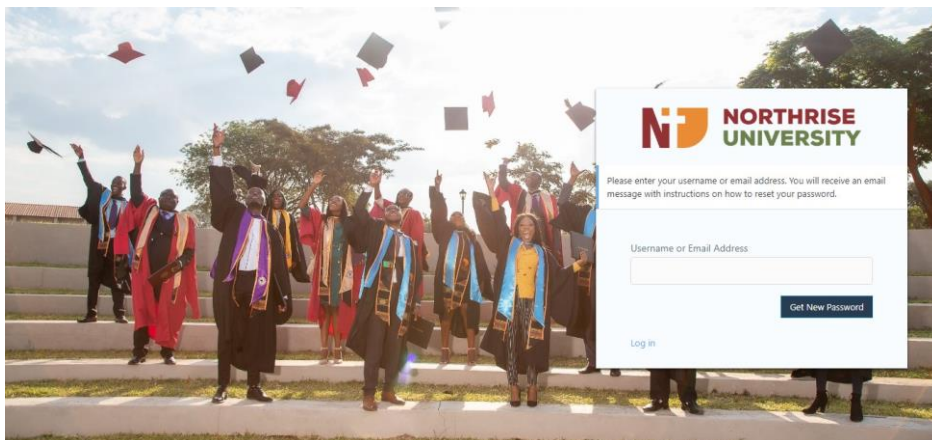
LOGGING IN

How to Log in to the Student Resource Portal

To access the portal, you need to log in using your student email address and password. Here is a step-by-step guide on how to log in to the student resource portal:

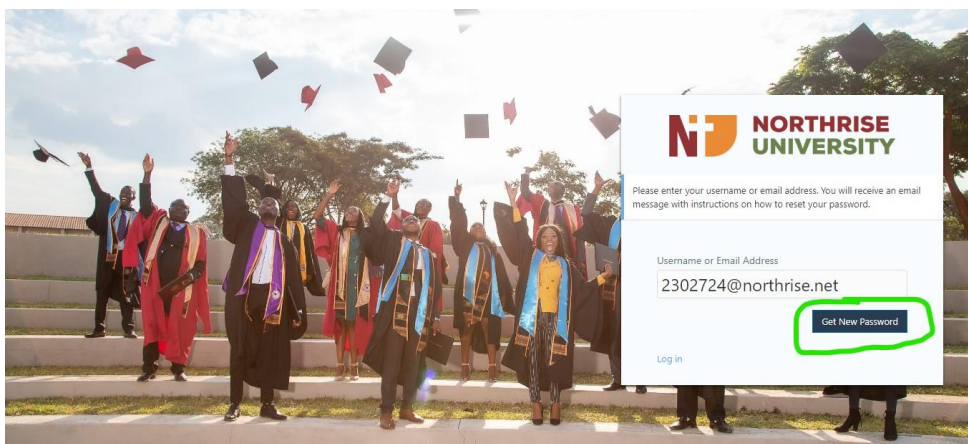
Step 1: Enter Your Student Email Address

Click the Link provided in the email from the Media and Communication department. The link will load the login page on our website. Enter your student email address in the provided field.



Step 2: Click on “Get New Password”

After entering your email address, click on the “Get New Password” button. This will initiate the password reset process.



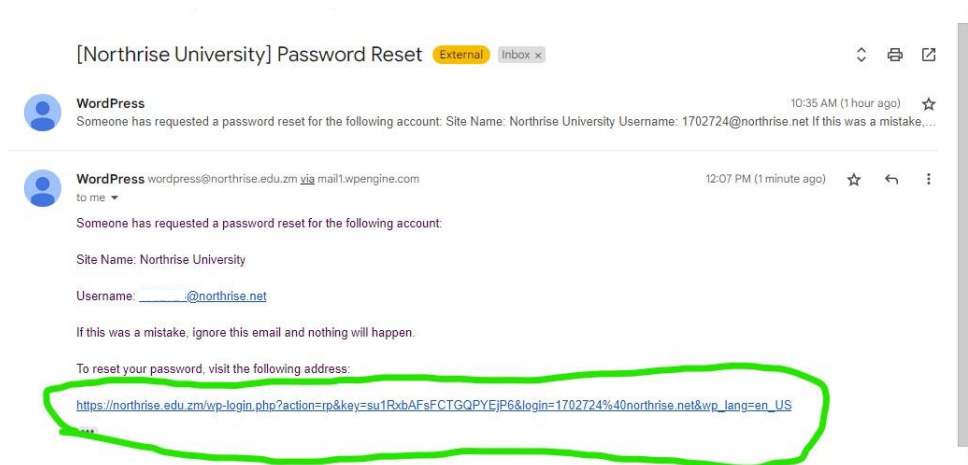
Step 3: Check Your Email Inbox for Instructions on How to Reset Your Password

You will receive an email with instructions on how to reset your password. Follow the instructions carefully to complete the password reset process.



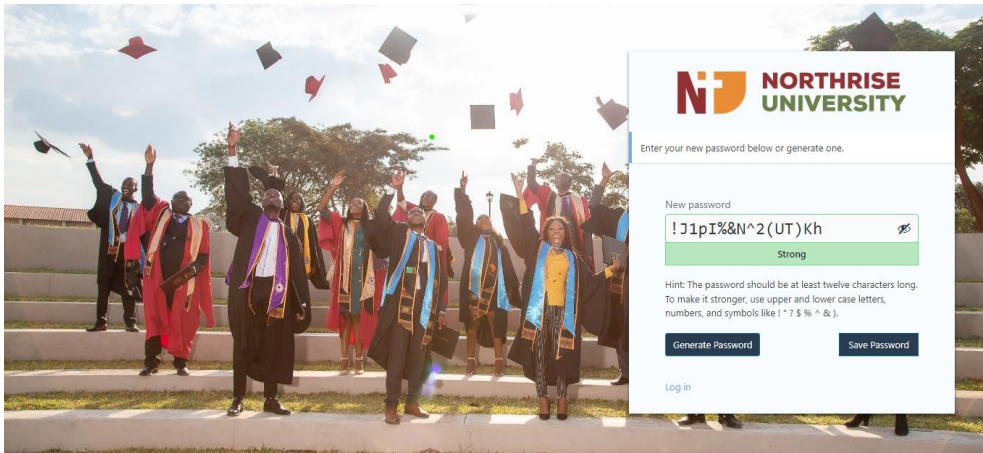
Step 4: Click on the Confirmation Link and Visit the Login Page

Once you have reset your password, click on the confirmation link in the email to verify your email address. You will then be redirected to the login page.



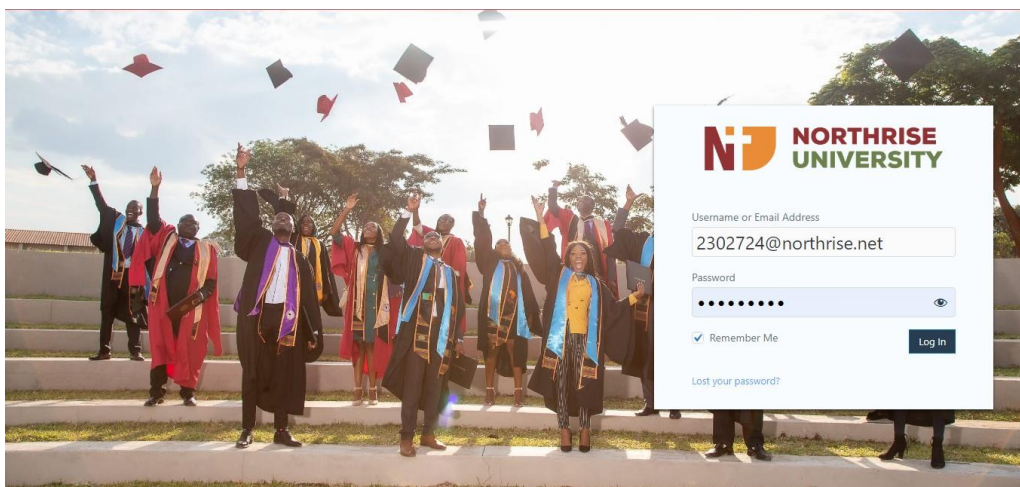
Step 5: Reset Your Password (First-Time Login Only)

If this is your first time logging in, you will be required to reset your password. Click on the link in the email you received and it will redirect you to the password reset page. You can enter a new password of your choice or regenerate one. Click on the “Save Password” button to complete the password reset process.

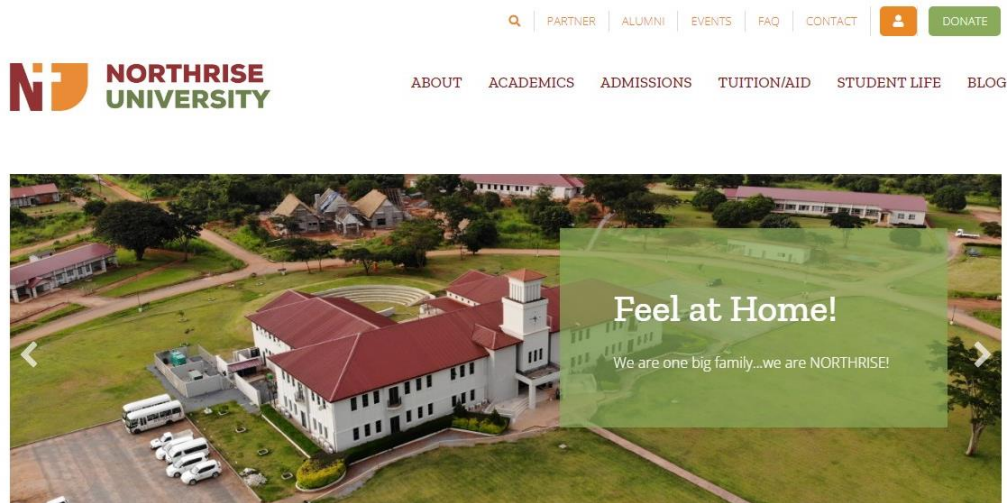


Step 6: Log in to the Student Resource Portal

Once you have reset your password, you will be redirected to the login page. Enter your student email address and new password to log in to the student resource portal.



After successfully logging in you will be redirected to the homepage of the student resource portal.

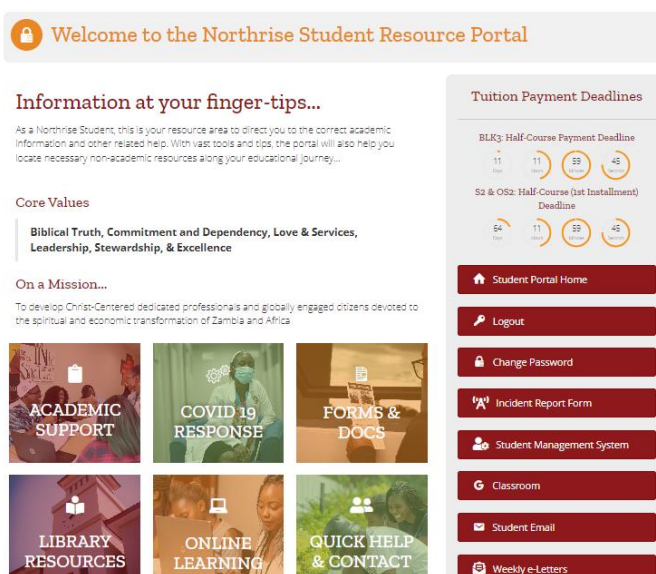


In The Student Portal:

Home Page

Once you are logged in to the portal, you will have access to various services and information. Access to these is all on the home page. Below are illustrations that will guide you on where to find what you are looking for.

1. Once you log in, scroll to the bottom. This is the overview of the student resource portal that should be on your screen.



2. Each of these buttons on the portal provides you with important information and resources that you may need.



- **Academic Support**

This button redirects you to a page having resources and information concerning any support or clarification you may need concerning your academics. It has information regarding:

- Examinations, both for online and day students.

Exams & Results

Examinations are part of ongoing assessments that are designed to test a student's comprehension of knowledge and acquired skills in a given course or unit of study. At Northrise, different types of exams are administered in different weeks during each given semester. Though each exam carries a different weighting, students are encouraged to take every exam seriously as each score acquired counts towards the final grade of a course.

Northrise administers a maximum of three (3) exams in each course, namely, Quizzes, Mid-Semester and Final Exams.

Campus Exams

For courses running on-site, NU administers campus-based exams.

- **Quizzes** are written online using Trelson. Trelson can be accessed via your Northrise University google account. These exams are administered in Week 6 of a given Semester.
- **Mid-Semester Exams** are paper-based exams written on campus predominately in Week 8 of the Semester.
- **Final Exams** are also paper-based exams written in the Final Exam Week at the end of each Semester.

Online Exams

NU administers Online Exams for all courses running online. Instead of Quizzes and Mid-Semester Exams, online students take on other online assessments as part of their Course Plan.

- **Final Exams** are written online in the Final Exam Week at the end of each Semester.
- **Trelson** is the Online Exam Software that Northrise uses to administer its online exams. Using Trelson, Northrise is able to offer its students reliable and proven technology for taking online exams from virtually anywhere.

Onsite Library Usage

Book Loaning Procedure:

Access to the Library is reserved for community members with a valid Northrise University ID Card. Library members have the following privileges:

Undergraduates/Postgraduates students

- 2 days to one week loan periods depending on material usage and availability.
- Loan renewal limit of up to 2 times.

Faculty staff/Members of staff

- 3 months loan period.
- Loan renewal limit of up to 3 times.

Short Loans

The overnight short loan period is between 16:00 hours to before 10:00 hours the next day for limited materials and high-demand books used within the library.

NOTES:

1. Students that are not registered for classes but finishing up an incomplete class, thesis, or research may apply for borrowing privileges.
2. Students' access to physical materials (Books, Journals, Computers, etc.) is only applicable within the Library.

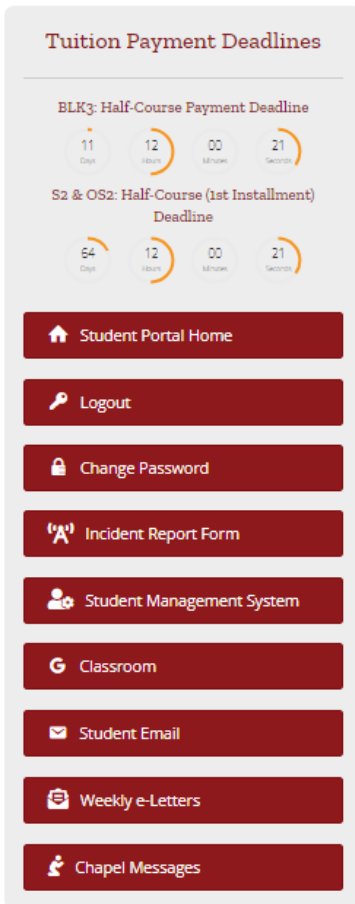

- Listen to past and current Chapel sermons in the student portal uploaded under one roof using the Chapel Messages button
