The student resource portal is an online platform that provides students with access to important resources such as course materials, announcements, forms, and academic information.

LOGGING IN

How to Log in to the Student Resource Portal

To access the portal, you need to log in using your student email address and password. Here is a step-by-step guide on how to log in to the student resource portal:

Step 1: Enter Your Student Email Address

Click the Link provided in the email from the Media and Communication department. The link will load the login page on our website. Enter your student email address in the provided field.



Step 2: Click on "Get New Password"

After entering your email address, click on the "Get New Password" button. This will initiate the password reset process.



Step 3: Check Your Email Inbox for Instructions on How to Reset Your Password

You will receive an email with instructions on how to reset your password. Follow the instructions carefully to complete the password reset process.



Step 4: Click on the Confirmation Link and Visit the Login Page

Once you have reset your password, click on the confirmation link in the email to verify your email address. You will then be redirected to the login page.

Step 5: Reset Your Password (First-Time Login Only)

If this is your first time logging in, you will be required to reset your password. Click on the link in the email you received and it will redirect you to the password reset page. You can enter a new password of your choice or regenerate one. Click on the "Save Password" button to complete the password reset process.





Step 6: Log in to the Student Resource Portal

Once you have reset your password, you will be redirected to the login page. Enter your student email address and new password to log in to the student resource portal.



After successfully logging in you will be redirected to the homepage of the student resource portal.
